Indorama scouts for site for second plant

New Delhi: Indorama Synthetic (India) Ltd, India's second largest synthetic fibre maker, is looking for a site near a port to build a new plant that would almost double its capacity to 1 million tonne by 2015 as demand for the commodity rises overseas. "We (have a) target to identify the site in next three months," said chairman and managing director O.P. Lohia. "It will be a port location, which will help us increase our exports."
